PRESIDENT /TREASURER'S REPORT: This report and financials were made available to members present at this General Meeting. Peter Sobey spoke on these reports. He also reported on current ongoing projects. Plans in place for the permanent stage in readiness for the base and structure for the sail and currently considering all the options and concerns including wiring, buried water main, avoiding the scar tree, etc. Hoping to start on the Monday after the Carols; April for structure on top of the concrete; VBCA contribution \$34,500 for stage; \$5,000+ for Reserve lighting; old wooden tables in front of "trailer stage" very old and need replacing - VBCA to look to replace these and move to the other side of the trees. Peter Sobey, Carole Andersen and Pat Greenwood attended NVC recently regarding new NVC conditions about volunteer risk and contractors. Due to all the extra responsibilities and rules, VBCA has received Pat's resignation from the Executive. She is happy to continue working with the CRT Team.

Through the Commonwealth Bank Not-For-Profit Scheme a framed Treasurer's Award Certificate was presented to Peter Sobey by VBCA member Gary Suter.

It was moved Peter Sobey and seconded Gary Suter that these financial and President's reports be accepted.

#### **GENERAL BUSINESS:**

- 1. Approved DA relating to Part Lot 8, 22 Valla Beach Road: The current DA will lapse July 2025. VBCA's sub committee is researching this issue options to build with VBCA becoming incorporated this would involve membership fees, etc but then VBCA could not be a Management Committee of NVC more grants available as separate incorporated body. Project cost would be over \$300,000 possible pathway for Alithia Learning to use its DA application through Council and VBCA to align with Alithia. Trying to prepare documentation so that when grant funding becomes available, it can be applied for. Time lapse may be approved for another 5 years or so. John Windmill has been seeking help from Michael Coulter to try and find out the actual dimensions of the land.
- 2. Local News Shared (LNS) Project through FRRR Carole Andersen gave a brief report; grant initially for one year (from November 2021) but this Project has been a long process; an extension was granted to 1st March 2024. It has given opportunity for the 4 newsletter publishers in the Valley to work on communication, exchange ideas, strategies for the future, computer training and youth involvement. Evaluation processes through FRRR this coming week.
- 3. Valla Beach Family Christmas Kerri Mergan reported that the organising and preparations are going well great committee different format this year more contemporary a lot of local performers and singers giving of their time freely. It will start with kids activities, then musical entertainment, performers and Carol singing and will end with local fire twirlers. 2NVR will be live streaming the event. Kerri asked VBCA whether it would be okay to purchase some battery powered fairy lights for some of the trees at the Reserve to add to the atmosphere. Agreed. To be noted that at this meeting, Matthew Sykes presented NVC's formal approval for the event.

- **4. Anderson Park report from Lori Warren:** VBCA sent a letter to NVC 16.10.23 about a new Parks Manager NVC still looking into this NVC's Stephen Lloyd has been given this position for the next 6 months. NVC's Bede Spannagle will get Stephen Lloyd to make contact with Lori about what plans could be possible for Anderson Park in the future.
- **5. Permanent Stage at the Reserve:** Dealt with by Peter Sobey in his reports.
- **6.** The annual "**Valla Expressions**" art and craft fair will be held at the Valla Beach Community Hall from Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> January 2024 until Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> January 2024. This is the seventh year of the popular exhibition showcasing the work of twelve local artists and craftspeople who will be displaying their original and unique works of art with all exhibits available for purchase. Exhibitors will include jewellery, wood carving, painting, ceramics, photography, fabric art and driftwood lamps. The fair is held over nine days with credit card facilities available and is open 10am until 5pm. Report from Julie Collins.

**CRT report -** Julie Collins reported that the Community Resilience Team was an initiative of Red Cross to provide information and pathways that communities could do during an emergency of any type. Following the education sessions with the RFS and a fire simulation demonstration in July, our local CRT Team has produced an information sheet to highlight the need to prepare for this bushfire season. Our street coordinators will be delivering them during this coming week and can answer any questions that residents may have about having a fire plan.

**Defib report** - Julie Collins reported that the seven Defibs are checked monthly by volunteers and are all in good working order. None have been used in an emergency yet. We have been trialling a tracker on the south beach unit and it is remotely monitored by a company in Sydney. If it is suitable, each unit will have one installed.

It is important that everyone has an emergency contact who can access the Defib while someone else is calling the ambulance or performing CPR. One solution is to issue a whistle to each house which is used to alert a neighbour to fetch the Defib. There will be another public information session about the Defibs at the Wool Shed to highlight their use and basic CPR. Date to be advised.

Resident Darren Squibb asked about the possibility of another Defib near Swordfish Drive and into the new estate = new houses. The initial cost of a Defib machine is \$3,500. Fundraising would be needed. Great fundraising and generosity for the initial costs for the 7 Defib machines.

- 7. "Shared Zone" sign at the northern end of Cockburn St request from resident Chris Robinson reply from NVC's Keith Williams (Manager Technical Services) stated that 'shared zones' are reserved for busy shopping precincts where Traffic calming or suitable treatments must be provided. Keith suggested either a road narrows sign or a pedestrian sign similar to those installed on Valla Beach Road would warn drivers to be careful. Discussion followed. It was agreed by all present that we ask NVC to install a pedestrian sign.
- 8. Resident Vanessa Cain contacted VBCA about **possible herbicide spraying and killing of shrubs** near the end of Gregory St carpark Vanessa away atm and not able to attend this meeting she used the Antenno App to contact NVC and the reply from NVC was that they were not responsible for the dead native bushes. She also has concerns re **migratory birds** she will contact NVC again about installing **larger "no dog" signs.**

There was general discussion regarding the confusing signs which show where you can go with your dog on a lead and allow them to run free. Need simpler signage. Wires member Darren stated that the middle Valla carpark down along Thompson St overlooking the lagoon is a designated migratory bird nesting area. NVC's Bede Spannagle stated that the current Ranger combines his Nambucca Valley Work with Bellingen Council. The Ranger reports each fortnight to each Council about any fines being issued - could be for not picking up after their dog, keeping control of their dog, not on a lead, dogs in 'no dog' areas, etc.

The subject of 4WD on beaches was then brought up and discussed at length. Gregory Street resident has suggested that Gregory and Buchanan Streets be made into a one way street - with cars going down Gregory and coming up Buchanan St. Discussed.

General discussion followed regarding the multitude of dog issues and complaints and the need for more regular patrols by Council's Ranger to help with the dog issues and illegal 4WDs. It was moved Graham Jones and seconded Kerri Mergan that VBCA write to NVC asking for:

- a) Dog signage needs to be clear and simple ie green arrow off leash area red arrow on leash area. \$378 fines could be issued. More presence of the Ranger.
- b) 4WD on beaches, especially North Valla Beach and into the dunes near Jagun Nature Reserve. What can be done? More presence of the Ranger. All in favour.
- 9. Resident Zoie Byrne emailed VBCA about **lowering the speed along East West Road** native animals being hurt and killed she was advised to write to Transport NSW in October she is waiting for reply Carole has forwarded to Zoie information re Transport NSW Nambucca Valley Community Forum on 29.11.23. The question was asked whether there has there been any consultation with other residents by Zoie?

  VBCA to raise this matter with NVC traffic committee. Darren Squibb (Wires) spoke re native animals being killed along East West Road, Ocean View Drive and Thompson Street. Darren moved and seconded Peter Sobey that VBCA request NVC's traffic committee to utilise its mobile radar units in these areas. All in favour.
- **10. VV Printing options -** Due to rising printing and paper costs, VBCA is considering going down the path of only printing a small number of VVs to be placed at the Cafes and Pharmacy and no postbox deliveries in the future but asking residents to access the newsletter online. An anonymous survey has been produced and is available now through various channels to gauge the community's thoughts. Survey forms also available on the entrance table tonight. Upcoming meeting flyers could still be delivered.
- **11.** Lock the Gate against mining Georgette Allen from Nambucca Valley Conservation Group spoke to the meeting our Govt is supporting start-up companies for mining antimony. This is not appropriate and certainly not in the Nambucca Valley. Mining would end up ruining our water ways. There is a public meeting at Macksville Ex Services Auditorium 5.30pm Tuesday 14 November. Georgette encouraged all concerned residents to attend.
- **12. Darren Squibb spoke in relation to recycling** Darren has received great support from VBCA over the years a rare Horus bird has been spotted in the Oakes State Forest, Kalang this may prevent logging in that particular area.
- **13.** Kerri Mergan brought up the idea of a **tidal pool at Valla Beach** any interest? Brief discussion. Matthew Sykes mentioned the one at Sawtell is almost unusable due to algae buildup. Valla Beach is a very special conservation area bounded by bushland and there are many Indigenous sacred land pockets and rivers.

**Chairperson Peter Sobey:** Is there any other General Business to be discussed tonight? If not, I'll declare the meeting closed at 8.38pm - thank you all for your attendance.
