VALLA BEACH COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION (VBCA) REPORT

"Good news this month that the NSW Government has put forward legislation to establish the **Great Koala National Park**. The park will protect forests from logging and allow the biodiversity of the area to flourish. It is important to realise that our local area is a world biodiversity hotspot. With all the pressures on the natural environment it is so vital to protect what little remains. If we don't act this diversity will disappear and we will all be poorer for it.

The Al camera at the Valla Beach Road intersection with Giinigay Way has been removed and we await the imminent communications from Transport for NSW as to the proposed plan for the intersection. The message to reduce speed seems

to be slowly gaining traction. It is always good advice to slow down, especially on the roads you use most often. Most accidents occur within 8km from home. That is why I moved!

We have been making changes in the way we run the Valla Beach Market. Last year we started using the new stage and it has been a great success. This made the old stage, based upon a flat bed trailer, redundant. Over the last couple of months we have employed the many skills of the blokes at the Nambucca Heads Mens Shed to design and build 8 trolleys to store and move the tables, chairs, marquees, and bollards that we store in the shed. The use of these trolleys will eliminate the double handling of all these items and save our volunteers from having to lift everything onto the trailer. We have sold the trailer which has paid for the cost of building the trolleys.

I have asked for good weather for the October 4th Market so come along and bring all your coins, if you still have any, to put in the donation tins. The money will go to our Family Christmas Evening on 12 December.

We are a Committee of Council run by volunteers and we are always open for people to become involved, either in a big way or a small way. All of the contributions, from staffing the greeting tables at the market, to helping to set up the annual art show, to being a committee member, and everything else is what makes our community a better place. "Valla Beach Community Defib Project

There have been three defibrillators out of use in the past month owing to storm damage on Anderson Park and the Beach House, and vandalism at the Lions Park unit.

Fortunately none of the defibrillators were damaged or stolen but the cabinets and stands have had to be repaired. Urunga Men's Shed have done a great job in securing the two damaged ones to their stands. The Lions Park cabinet had to be completely replaced and the men's shed have managed to repair the old one so that we have a spare. They have had little use in the last few months which is good news. All seven are regularly checked by their minders and are ready for use if the need arises.

2026 will be the tenth Valla Expressions Art Show and it promises to be bigger and better than ever. The show will be held from the 4th to the 12th of January 2026 in the Valla Beach Community Hall on Valla Beach Road. You may have seen us on one our many walks to the Gaagal (Ocean), the Bindarray (River) and Wawaa (Bush). In the Yamaarr class we have been exploring clay and design in Term 1. This sparked the relationship between the Preschool and Village Pottery, our local Ceramics Studio.Matt and his team welcomed us in with open arms showing us around his pottery wonderland filled with high quality water filters & local artisan's clay creations fired onsite in their industrial sized kiln. We started our exploration posing the question "What is clay?" to the

We got some of Matt's amazing, recycled clay and each child made a clay work. Matt invited the class to fire their works in the large kiln; the children were so excited and curious to see the process from start to finish. The clay was such good quality and a pleasure to work with; we have now started to purchase all of our clay locally. So, from everyone at Valla Community Preschool we send out a big thankyou to Village Pottery and hope to continue to nurture this new community link.

From some of our clay creations, we have been working on a collaborative mosaic, which has led our children into planning and designing their own individual mosaic creations.
